Thanks to everyone who helped with the jet rally last month. It was a great success; the profit for each club was around \$ 954. There is an additional \$ 603 in gate collection money currently in Jim Hiller's possession. This money will be used as follows: \$75 will go to Jim for miscellaneous expenses, 1/2 will go to Rich Allison for letting us conduct the event at their field, and the remaining money (approximately \$112 each) will be split between the two clubs. This will probably be our last jet rally; we'll be moving on to other things next year as the Nighthawks do not want to participate in this joint effort again. They want to conduct the event themselves.

Joe Lewis is now president of Nighthawks as well as the Aeros. If re-elected for the Aeros for 2010, Joe is committed to keeping the two clubs separate and won't let one interfere with the other. - Field Marshall:** Skunks aren't digging for grubs, so grub control must be working.
- Safety:** Keith Anderson has been emptying trash and recycling for the club and has discovered that people are throwing Li-poly batteries into the trash. This is absolutely not permitted. All members must take the responsibility of disposing of their own batteries, and not do so at the club field. This is a safety problem and will not be tolerated.
- There was a report of a "startling experience" that happened recently at the field. We will not discuss the specifics here, but Joe will discuss with the member involved. This is just a reminder to show courtesy for fellow pilots and do not create a situation that could startle a pilot and cause a crash.
- It's the time of year when we tend to become lax regarding safety. This is a reminder to always use hold-downs or get a helper when starting planes; we don't want anyone to lose a hand or get a serious injury.
- C-130's and other aircraft fly over our field; be sure to stay clear of them, even if you are lower. If something happened that was perceived as interfering with their flight path, it could be the end of this field. All that would have to happen is for a pilot to say that they experienced this behavior at an outer marker for the airport and we could be shut down. We do not want to lose our field; if you see any aircraft flying overhead, be sure to stay clear and low.
