REPORTS:

 These are just suggestions and next meeting we'll discuss in more detail, but be thinking about dates
 and ideas. Joe would like to space them out. Joe will meet with surrounding clubs in the near
 future and ensure that no events overlap and adjust accordingly.

We have enough money in the 50/50 fund and we'll be having pizza at the November meeting.
