### REPORTS:

**President:** Minutes stand approved as written. On December 13<sup>th</sup>, Luke's RC will begin the indoor flying at Farmer Jim's Indoor Soccer Field from 9 a.m. until noon. The cost to fly is \$10.

**Unfinished Business** Swap shop will be Sunday, February 14<sup>th</sup> at the Trumbull County Fairgrounds. Lori suggested that instead of just printing tickets on computer paper, we have them professionally printed. This will give a more professional look as well as have a stub for the buyer to keep as a reminder of the date. Bill W. made a motion to get tickets printed, Joe R. seconded, and membership voted to expend the money for tickets. Bill W. said when he had tickets printed, the cost was around \$50 per 1,000. Lori will contact local printer to get a price and have printed to be sent out with newsletter. Cost of tickets will be \$1 each or 6 for \$5.

President appointed the committee that will organize and layout the field and rules for the new designed helicopter area at the field. Those members are Joe L., Joe R. Bill W., Patrick C., and Joe T. There also was discussion on how members felt about how this should be set up. Several ideas/suggestions were that it is best not to eliminate a station. Even though only four planes can be in the air at one time and we have five stations, we need that extra station for people to be setting up ready to fly. Also, someone mentioned to include control line in discussion of set up as we do have at least one person flying control line. Along the lines of changes, there was a previous request to extend the runway 25 feet to the west. Ray P. offered to approach the fair board. Bill W. suggested that we don't do anything with this suggestion until the changes have been finalized for the new heli area and everyone agreed that was a good idea.

At the January 2010 meeting, we will need to finalize the dates for our events so that we can notify other local clubs that we want to reserve those days.

There will be an informal Freeze Fly on January 1, 2010, weather permitting. Centaurs are having an event that day as well.

**New Business** There was discussion about having the newsletter on the website. Joe L. said it wasn't a good idea to make it public, but our members voted for this to be on the website as long as the treasurer's report was removed. The newsletter will stay on the website and Lori will only list first name and last initial of references to members as suggested by some members.

No new members at this meeting.

**Tips/Hints** Doug H. offered a hint that when you have a larger area to mask off when painting, use plastic wrap (like Saran Wrap) and mask down the edges with masking tape. Thanks, Doug!
