President: Motion was made to accept the minutes from last month's meeting by Cliff Hineman, seconded by Ray Reghetti; motion carried.

Thanks to everyone who offered their support for the Electric Fly-In. There was good attendance and participation. Revenue from the event was \$ 783 and net profit was \$ 436.95. Special thanks to Keith Anderson for donating \$ 25 to the club from his share of the winnings of the 50/50 raffle. Because the field was wet during the event, there were some ruts left from parking. Another special thanks to Bill Stavana for rolling the field after the event.

Vice Pres.: Nothing special to report. Will be taking minutes in secretary's absence.

Secretary: Not present.

Treasurer: New membership laminated tags were made by Dale Hatch and did not cost the club anything additional as the materials were left over from last year. Cards will be mailed to members who get a mailed newsletter and the rest will be distributed personally. Doug Hannas recommended that we avoid duplication of cost and effort next year by simply having members use their AMA card, when we again would have to purchase materials.

Field Marshall: Discussion regarding collapsed drain pipe and resulting cavities in and around the runway. Digging up and replacing will likely restrict use of the facility for a few days. The week of the Trumbull County Fair would be a good time to do any kind of maintenance since the facility will be closed to all members/guests for flying of any kind. Doug suggested King Construction topsoil as a temporary repair. This may last 1 – 2 years before problems resurface. There was no motion proposed and issue remains undecided.

Safety: Nothing to report; just a reminder to all pilots to fly safely at all times.

Doug Hannas moved to give Luke a thank you card on behalf of the club in appreciate for the active support of our event. This was seconded by Rocky Flaviano and motion carried. Patrick will be seeing Luke on the 10th and offered to purchase and deliver a card signed by the Flying Aeros. He will also broach the consignment issue to initiate the conversation between Luke and Dave Rock.

Dave Rock suggest a work party for 7/31/2010, which is the day before the Fun Fly. This would be nothing formal; just show up and lend a hand.

John McCarty motioned to eliminate the helicopter area, Doug Hannas seconded the motion, and the motion carried by 9 to 1 (5 abstained from voting). It was agreed that helicopters and 3D airplanes would conform to the same rules as all other aircraft as they are current stated in the by-laws.

New Business Trumbull County Fair is June 27th through July 4th. The flying field will be closed with no exceptions.

Dave Rock is going to contact members who have not paid their dues.

Dale Anderson did not pick up his prize from the last event. Someone should contact him, but there were no volunteers.
